Applicants who applied in previous years, but **did not** receive a scholarship for the 2016/2017 academic year must re-apply with a complete application.

Recipients of a 2016/2017 academic year United Association Scholarship who wish to be considered again must, at a minimum, complete an “updated information” application found on the website and submit their current transcripts and certifications from their educational institutions that they remain in good standing. Because awards do not automatically renew, previous award winners may find it in their interest to complete the full application.

The three most important considerations in determining who receives a UA scholarship are the applicant’s academic standing, personal achievements and community participation. However, financial consideration may also be taken into account in situations of a “tie-breaker.” Six scholarships will be awarded.
